Selection shortcuts:

Shortcut	Description
р	Puts (pastes) before cursor.
P	Puts (pastes) after cursor.
ya}	Yanks all the statement block, including the braces.
ya}	Yanks all the statement block, including the braces.
yi}	Yanks all the text in the statement, excluding the braces.
$\mathtt{yt}\langle\mathtt{char} angle$	Yank 'til $\langle \mathtt{char} \rangle$.
уу	Yank current line.
Y	Yank to end of line \equiv y\$.
:%y	Yanks the entire file.

Search and replace:

Shortcut	Description
:.s/old/new/g	Replace all occurrences of text 'old' with 'new' in current line.
:%.s/old/new/g	Replace all occurrences of text 'old' with 'new' in entire file.

Navigation:

Shortcut	Description
{	Goto previous blank line.
}	Goto next blank line.
^B	Scroll back (up) one screenful.
^D	Scroll forward (down) one half a screen.
^F	Scroll forward (down) one screenful.
H	Place cursor at the top of the page.
L	Place cursor at the bottom of the page.
M	Place cursor at the middle of the page.
^U	Scroll up one half a screen.
z.	Put line with cursor at centre of the page.
zb	Put line with cursor at bottom of the page.
zt	Put line with cursor at top of the page.

Editing:

Shortcut	Description
~	Change case of character under cursor, advance cursor.
$\mathtt{c} \langle \mathtt{motion} \rangle$	Change text of movement command (motion) (delete and go into edit mode).
сс	Change current line (delete and go into edit mode).
$\mathtt{ct}\langle\mathtt{char} angle$	Change 'til \(\char \) (delete and go into edit mode).
CW	Change word (delete and go into edit mode).
cW	Change WORD (delete and go into edit mode).
C	Change to end of line (delete and go into edit mode) \equiv c\$.
$\mathtt{d} \langle \mathtt{motion} \rangle$	Delete text of movement command (motion)
dd	Delete current line.
dw	Delete current word.
dW	Delete current WORD.
$\mathtt{dt}\langle\mathtt{char}\rangle$	Delete 'til (char).
D	Delete to end of line $\equiv d$ \$.
${\tt gu} \langle {\tt motion} \rangle$	Change text of movement command (motion) to lower case.
guw	Change word under cursor to lower case.
${\tt gU} \langle {\tt motion} \rangle$	Change text of movement command (motion) to upper case.
gUw	Change word under cursor to upper case.
$\texttt{r}\langle\texttt{char}\rangle$	Replace character under cursor with $\langle char \rangle$.
u	Undo last change(s).
x	Delete character under cursor.
